

OAK and BUDS MEDALLION 60" Square

Fabric Selection **ADVICE!**

- This quilt includes Reproductions and Similar prints, Bali and Solids. Strive for a subtle blend within the color frame required (your choice). Mine is Rust-Teal-Chocolate-Olive and Ivory to Tan. What is yours?
- One **LARGE PRINT** should become your **FOCUS** fabric. Focus on small to medium scale prints and patterns. Include florals, geometrics, stripes, toile, etc...use it all!
- The Ivory to Tan background is progressive. Ivory in the center moves outward to Tan. Final border has both.
- My center fabric is cut from a **VINTAGE LINEN** tablecloth! Now think about that for a minute...options? Check fabric companies or quilt shop for color, price availability. I give you solid-KONA brand color options as well.
- Scrap fabrics can be used. There are just a few parts that require yardage (Oak leaves-2 fabrics: Bud and Flower stems/leaves-2 fabrics: Solid Center: Solid Light Tan for borders)

MATERIALS LIST

- 1/8 yd **Lightest White prints** assortment: border #2
- 1 yd **Ivory solid** (Kona #1181-Ivory): center, border #1
- 3/4 yd **Ivory prints** assortment (around Kona #1181): border #2, #3, #4
- 1/2 yd **Light Tan solid** (Kona #1306-Raffia): border #1, #3
- 3/4 yd **Med Tan prints** assortment (around Kona #1306): border #3, #4
- 3/4 yd **Large Olive Green print**: applique
Choose other colors from this piece!
- 1/4 yd **Light-Med Olive Green prints**: applique, border#1
- 1/4 yd **Med Olive Green prints** assortment: applique, border #1
- 3/8 yd **Dark Chocolate, Burgundy, Rust prints** assortment: applique, border #2
- 8" square **Chocolate print**: center applique
- 3/8 yd **Med Rust, Madder prints** assortment: applique, border #3
- 5/8 yd **Dark-Med Teal prints** assortment: applique, border #3
- 1/2 yd **Binding**: Chocolate/Teal Plaid
- 2 yds **Backing and Batting** @ 90"/109"

NOTE: *If you choose to make Half-square Triangles using commercial foundation paper products, you will need:*

88: 1 1/2" finished for border #2

44: 2" finished for border #1

28: 3" finished for border #3
