

The original quilt was discarded because it was too worn to be hung or displayed. She just wanted her auction money back, so it was offered to me for pennies! Circa 1835, appliqued with Top-Running stitch and quilted with very tiny stitches, many are 2-3 rows very closely aligned!

4-Block Quilt size: 84" square Block size: 36"

A Single-Block version, 48" square, is in parenthesis for all cutting and construction

PATTERN INCLUDES:

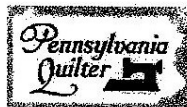
Instructions for *Back-Basting* applique preparation

MATERIALS

- (2 ½ yards) 5 ¾ yard of White/Cream for Background, Border And Binding
- (1 ¼ yards) 4 ¼ yards of Red for applique and Border #3
- (¾ yards) 3 yards of Green for applique and Border #1
- (54" square) 90" square of batting and backing fabrics
- Matching applique threads and needles:
(size 10-11 milliners/straw)
- If *Back-Basting* technique: quilting thread, size 9 milliner/straw needles
- If Template technique: 1-2 sheets template vinyl, fine tip marker, marking pencil

NOTE: If you choose to make half-square triangles using commercial paper foundation materials, you will need to make (160) 312: 2" finished half-square triangles. This will require (80) 156 foundation squares.
