

# Oak and Buds

*This design was taken right from a beautiful quilted vest...yes, cut from an early vintage quilt! I had to recreate it for myself in two fabrics: With honor and tribute to the original maker, I chose the Original colors for #1. Note the shade of green...fugitive green to be specific! The second version was to draw in granddaughters who both live in wine, purple and white bedrooms! #2 got them on board with eyes wide open! Both love it. Who gets it?*

**Quilt size: 30" square    Block size: 22"**

## **MATERIALS**

*If selecting #2 fabric choices, apply background yardage. For all other fabrics, choose random amounts to complete project. Fat Quarters are applicable.*

- 1 yard of White/Cream for Background and border
- ½ yards of Very Light Olive Green for applique
- 1/3 yards of Red or choose an assortment of scraps for applique and border
- 1 Fat Quarter Orange for applique
- 36" square of batting and backing fabrics
- Matching applique threads and needles (size 10-11 milliners/straw)
- If Back-Basting technique: quilting thread, size 9 milliner/straw needles
- If Template technique: 1 sheet template vinyl, fine tip marker, marking pencil

*NOTE: If you choose to make half-square triangles using commercial paper foundation materials, you will need to make 88: 2" finished half-square triangles. This will require 44 foundation squares.*
